Work Meeting

June 21, 2007

PRESENT: Mayor Malchoff Davis, Trustee Norm Youmans, Trustee Tom Hickey (absent), Trustee Warner Yankee, Trustee Dave Tackman, DPW Superintendent Doug Riggs, Joni Hinds, Clyde Lewis, Tom & Judy Mirizio.

CALLED TO ORDER: by Mayor Davis at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Trustee Tackman made motion to approve the minutes from 6/5/07 Board Meeting, second by Trustee Youmans, all in favor

ADDITIONS TO ABSTRACT: Mayor Davis made motion to approve additions to abstract # 1 vouchers # 59-66, second by Trustee Youmans, all in favor. Hold check to appraiser until approval received for revised appraisal from Dept of Parks & Rec.

PARKS & REC ENTERTAINMENT: Trustee Tackman made motion to approve a magic show to entertain the children at the Parks and Rec. program. Our cost is \$200. Oswego County will pay for half of the total cost, second by Mayor Davis, all in favor.

VILLAGE HALL UPDATE: A meeting with USDA took place on June 21st. Some issues discussed were:

- Where to go, how to proceed
- Volunteer labor – a viable way to save money and have an affordable Village Hall
- Bid roof separately
- Schedule and plan volunteer days
- Get architect Randy Coogan's advise regarding the demolition
- Any demolition done prior to bid will save the Village money.

SEMINAR: It is mandatory for Planning and Zoning Board members to complete four hours of training. Send information to members of the Appeals Board. Start soliciting planning board members, maybe those from prior committee.

JOHN VANBODEN: After some discussion Mayor Davis made motion to credit Mr. Vanboden's w/s account by \$564.06 with the understanding that he will take care of the relieved amount on his county taxes for the property he purchased at the county auction, second by Trustee Youmans, all in favor.

TOM MIRIZZIO: After much discussion regarding Mr. Mirizio's w/s charges, Mayor Davis made motion to reduce laundromat units charged by 2 sewer units (bill 4 sewer units now) with the understanding this issue will be presented to the new Board and will be encouraged to address the Sewer Law to make it more fair and equitable, second by Trustee Youmans, all in favor.

150th UPDATE: Board gave approval for portable bathrooms to be placed at the park during the 150th celebration for additional restrooms.

NEXT MEETING: The next Village Board meeting, the Annual Organizational Meeting will be held on Tuesday July 10, 2007 at 7:30 pm as determined and set at last years organizational meeting in July 2006.

MEETING ADJOURNED: Mayor Davis made motion to adjourn meeting at 9:15 pm, second by Trustee Tackman, all in favor.
