

Village of Cleveland Work Meeting January 20, 2009

PRESENT: Mayor Malchoff Davis, Trustee Joe Domachowske, Trustee Debbie Kite, DPW Superintendent Doug Riggs, John & Joni Hinds, Paul Baxter-Tug Hill Commission

CALLED TO ORDER: by Mayor Davis at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADDITIONS TO BILLS Abstract #8: Mayor made motion to approve Additions to Abstract #8, vouchers # 390-393, seconded by Trustee Domachowske, all in favor, motion carried.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: John Hinds addressed Board regarding the sale of 1994 Freightliner/ Saulsbury Rescue Pumper. A bid was received for \$35,000 but did not meet the minimum bid requirement of \$40,000. A purchase offer for \$44,000 was received from Command Fire Apparatus. John recommends that the Village Board accept the offer. Mayor made motion to accept purchase offer for \$44,000 for the 1994 Rescue Pumper, second by Trustee Kite, all in favor, motion carried. A bill of sale will be presented to Mayor for his signature. Also fax copy of signed purchase offer to CFA.

CODE ENFORCEMENT:

1. Board discussed letter to violators: need to draft and contact Attorney for review to decide on the order of time.
 - remedy violation is OK
 - remedy violation final notice, review timing
 - Accusatory instrument
2. Fire Inspections: Suggested Fees: Business and commercial fire inspections, \$50.00 which includes one re-inspection. Any other re-inspections would be charged an additional \$25.00.
3. Operating Permit: One operating permit fee that would include fire inspections. Assembly groups would have different fees. (A2 - \$100.00, A3 - \$50.00). Mayor made motion to approve these fees as Code Enforcement Officer has presented and will include cost of annual fire inspection, second by Trustee Domachowske, all in favor, motion carried.

CLEANING, VILLAGE HALL: 2 applications were received. The Board requested Evelyn Fehrman be contacted and offered the position at \$11.00/hour contingent upon the hours she is available. Must be able to work 2-3 hours per week during the Village Hall business hours.

PAUL BAXTER: The Tug Hill October meeting that the Village agreed to host will be changed from Oct 27th at 4:00 to Wed October 28th from 10:00-12:00. The next meeting will be in Altmar on 1/28/09 at 10:00 am.
