

**PRESENT:** Mayor Malchoff Davis, Trustee Debbie Kite, Trustee Joseph Carr, Trustee Joe Domachowske, Trustee Norm Youmans

**CALLED TO ORDER:** by Mayor Davis at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. The purpose of this meeting is to review the 2010/11 budget.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Mayor Davis made motion to approve minutes for April 13, 2010 Board Meeting, second by Trustee Kite, all in favor.

**ADDITIONS TO ABSTRACT:** Mayor made motion to approve addition to Abstract #11 voucher # 539, second by Trustee Carr, all in favor.

**BOARD OF ELECTIONS:** The Village of Cleveland entered into an agreement with the Oswego County Board of Elections for the purpose of conducting a Primary Election, if any, on September 14, 2010 and a General Election on November 2, 2010 at the Cleveland Village Hall. The Village Board meeting scheduled for September 14<sup>th</sup> will need to be changed if a primary is held.

**BOY SCOUT EAGLE PROJECT:** The Board has not yet determined where the flagpole should be located. It will need to be placed where it will not interfere with snow removal. Trustee Kite will inform Eagle Scout candidate Matt Martin that the Board would like a maintenance free pole to be placed rather than steel. Donations will be accepted to cover the extra cost. The Board discussed other items that will need to be completed at the Village Hall including a sign, a retaining wall, steps and sidewalk from 49 to the parking lot and landscaping.

**DOG CONTROL:** Trustee Youmans stated that dogs license fees for dogs living in the Village of Cleveland are collected through the Town of Constantia. It is his understanding that one of the purposes of dog licenses is to offset the cost of the Dog Control Officer. He feels that the village should collect their own fees or consolidate with the Town. Trustee Youmans will talk with the Town regarding his concerns.

**BUDGET REVIEW:** Trustee Domachowske presented edits to the already revised preliminary budget. The Mayor stated that major cuts were made this year, taxes were not increased, raises were not given to the employees and no one was fired.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** The Board closed regular meeting and entered into an Executive Session to discuss subjects relating to employee's wages.

**Re-Open REGULAR MEETING**

Mayor Davis made a motion that the Board agree to present the preliminary budget as reviewed and edited at a public hearing on May 11, 2010, second by Trustee Carr, all in favor.
